Why: This local sextet recorded its second CD with renowned producer Tom Rothrock (Beck, James Blunt, Foo Fighters) at The Factory Studios in town and then mixed it in L.A. for mega-pro sound. But that's not the reason you should be interested in this group. Rather, you should be awed by the beauty of lead singer Koralee Tonnack's voice, the orchestral instrumental interplay between multi-instrumentalist whiz Jane Gowan, guitarist Jon Roper and keyboardist James Ong, and the driving rhythm section of bassist Al MacInnes and drummer Eduardo Ottoni. Highly recommended for fans of everything from Coldplay and Eisley to classic Canadiana like Sarah McLachlan. "Today," the available download from [spygirlmusic.com](http://spygirlmusic.com), is just plain huge-sounding and proves that this band has grown leaps and bounds since its accomplished debut. This group deserves to be playing bigger venues to larger, adoring audiences.
